


Year 11 2017 Support, Intervention and Actions


From Monday 15th May pupils will follow an adapted timetable that ensures that whenever a pupil is not in examinations they are engaged in purposeful revision activity.

All students will need to be in school from 15th May to 16th June (AM) in full school uniform, so they can take part in the sessions staff will put on specially designed to give them support for their upcoming examinations.

After 16th June pupils need only attend school, in full uniform, for the examinations that are left and may remain at home otherwise.

Some pupils will be taking the ECDL course in the week beginning 19th and 26th June, they will be notified separately and will need to be in school every day until the course is complete. Again, pupils will need to be in full school uniform.

Exact details of which sessions will be run throughout the exam period will be published nearer the time.

REVISION PLANNING

This information is to support your revision strategy, when to plan your time and prioritise subjects for the forthcoming GCSE exams.

When do I start revision?

If you are thinking about planning your revision you are ready to be doing some revision. February half term is your first revision holiday. You should have your time planned for this week and onwards from then until your exams. 12 weeks of intensive revision time is essential for most exams to practise, memorise, and embed your knowledge and understanding. At the 6 week mark you should be starting to practise questions, technique, time planning and answering style based on key words and question stems (the focus of the question). The night before the exam should be just a quick re-cap and practise on topics you find particularly challenging in exams.

How do I plan my time effectively?

Using the exam timetable is a good way to prioritise based on weeks and days until exams. Here are some useful guidelines to follow:

- Prioritise exams that come before the May holiday, give them more hours to start with on your time plan. English Lit, Paper 1 Non Calculator Maths, Core Science, French, Spanish, Paper 1 Geography, Textiles, ICT, PE, Media Studies, Business Studies Paper 1 will be over by May half term so give them priority now as you will have more hours in May half term and onwards for the other exams you take.
- Give more time to subjects that have more examinations- **Maths** has 3 papers, **English Lang** has 2 and **English Lit** has 2 papers and **these subjects** have basic expectations for a good pass for employers and colleges so give them more hours!
- **Attend all lessons right up to the day of the exam**, this is compulsory and these lessons will help add to your own revision time.
- Attend afterschool sessions, holiday sessions, these can make all the difference to your final grade.
- Once into **exam season**, night revision will be focussed to what you have the next day so use your day time to keep up with revision for other subjects in school and at weekends and holidays.
- **Use revision techniques** suited to the exam and your learning style. Check with your teacher for top tips, read the revision guides and use your family for testing support.

Example of time planning:

A student doing History, French, and PD as well as Eng Lang & Lit, Maths and Core and Additional Sciences will have 17 examinations to sit. Before May ½ term English Lit 2, French, Core Sciences 3 and Maths paper 1, 7 exams will be completed leaving only 10 exams- History paper 1 and 2, English Lang 1 and 2, Maths 2 and 3 and 3 Additional Science and 1 PD exam left to take. A revision timetable should reflect this shift of priorities and time allowance for these subjects.

Designing your revision plan:

A good revision plan should be:

Realistic: everyone has good intentions, but be careful not to set a plan you can't stick to. Nobody can do 12 hours of revision a day.

Detailed: a good plan breaks revision into chunks, specifies times for studying and assigns each time to a subject or topic.

Flexible: some topics are difficult and may take you longer than you planned. Don't be afraid to adjust your plan accordingly.
