Students who have passion for human rights and an interest in film making or students with passion for film making and an interest in human rights!

This series of three workshops is for young people in years 10-12. It will not only inform and engage them with human rights, but will encourage them to think about and articulate their responses to issues as diverse as homelessness, hate crime, food poverty, life expectancy and education.

They will work with University of York student volunteers and will be supervised by ISSP staff to create short films that reflect on their human rights journey. They will use the technique of film making in order to find new ways to express themselves and to raise awareness of causes they care about. In short - to create visual media with impact, to stimulate conversation, challenge discrimination and promote human rights.

The film they create will be screened at a special "premiere" event on the afternoon of Sunday 18th November, at The Mount School, as the finale to the YORights film festival. We hope that students, parents and friends will join us for the screening. More information on that will follow.

This is a FREE course of three active workshops for students in years 10-12 in the partnership schools and students should attend all 3 sessions: Thursday 8 November 6pm to 8pm, Saturday 10 November 10am -3pm and Thursday 15 November 6pm to 8pm. Students do not need to wear school uniform and, as is the norm with our events, will work in mixed school groups. The sessions take place in room AEW/003 (Alcuin East Wing) on the main Heslington West Campus at the University of York. There are maps on the University of York website.
