AM Registration –

Morning Break –

Break as usual, other than students who have an exam starting at 11.15 who should be in the dining hall ready to be called to line up outside the sports hall. Students who do not have an exam should go to P3 as usual.

Lunch Time –

Lunch as usual, other than students who have an exam starting at 1.45 who should be in the dining hall ready to be called to line up outside the sports hall. Students who do not have an exam should go to P5 as usual.

PM Registration –

In form rooms as usual, other than students who are in an exam.

Over these two weeks the form time programme will be suspended to allow students additional private study time. With this in mind, students should ensure they have with them revision guides, notes or any other appropriate revision material to make the best use of this time.
