

Dear Parent/Carer,

Bronze Duke of Edinburgh award - Year 9

I am writing to inform you of your son/daughters interest in taking on the Duke of Edinburgh Bronze Award Scheme at Vale of York Academy. This is an internationally recognised qualification that is highly regarded for job applications, college and university admissions.

The award will involve significant levels of commitment out of school from the students as they will need to spend 3-6 months completing volunteer work, developing a skill and completing a physical aspect of the award. The highlight of the award is the expedition; this gives the pupils the opportunity to be with friends for an overnight in the countryside. Students must be organised and not let it interrupt their school year preparations, there will be no exceptions for not doing homework/ coursework or keeping to timescales given by their teachers.

We work very hard to deliver this award and will support pupils throughout, however, students must be motivated and engaged in wanting to achieve this.

Those pupils who have signed up to the award need to cover essential training of navigation, cooking on expedition, camp craft, tent pitching, first aid and lots more. I will see pupils for a 6hour session and cover this training needed at school – date specified below.

It is a fantastic award to not only achieve in the end, but to embrace throughout, learning new skills, helping others through volunteering and taking part in physical activity. We strongly urge all students to consider the award and what it will in the future support them with. Please see the table below which gives you some ideas of each section. Key Expedition section dates

Proposed dates due to numbers of pupils signing up – confirmed dates will be sent once signed up.

Cost of the award

£230 to pay for running award costs, which covers the training day, day walk, expedition and camping. This also includes transport, campsite fees and equipment borrowing. £28 to pay for DofE enrolment - this pays for administration, welcome pack, certificate and DofE

system log on.

£12 to pay towards yearly licence of DofE that the school needs to pay Total - £270.00 for the award

If any students struggle with payment for this award, please contact Mr Rampling as we would like to ensure there aren't barriers to anyone wanting to undertake this award. Payments can be paid in instalments as per below or can be altered if needed.

<u>DofE Deposit</u> - £70.00 (Due by Friday 25^{th} October 2024) <u>Instalment 1</u> - £100.00 (Due by Friday 28^{th} February 2025) <u>Instalment 2 -</u> £100.00 (Due by Friday 6^{th} June 2025)

To reserve your place please pay the **deposit of £70 and return the attached enrolment form to Mr Rampling in school.** However, if you would like to pay the full £270 at once then please pay the £70 enrolment fee, £100 instalment 1 and £100 instalment 2 on the relevant parent pay tabs.

Payment can only be accepted via Parent Pay. Please complete the attached enrolment form to confirm you have paid.
