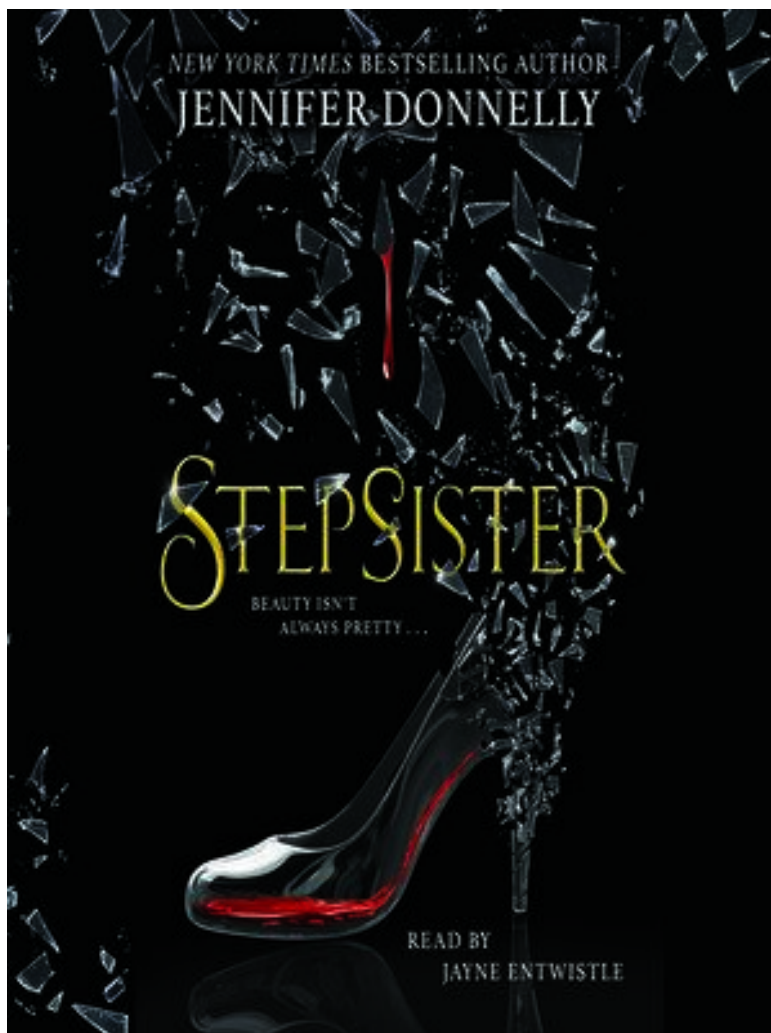
Celebrations in the library
