Yorkshire Pudding Day

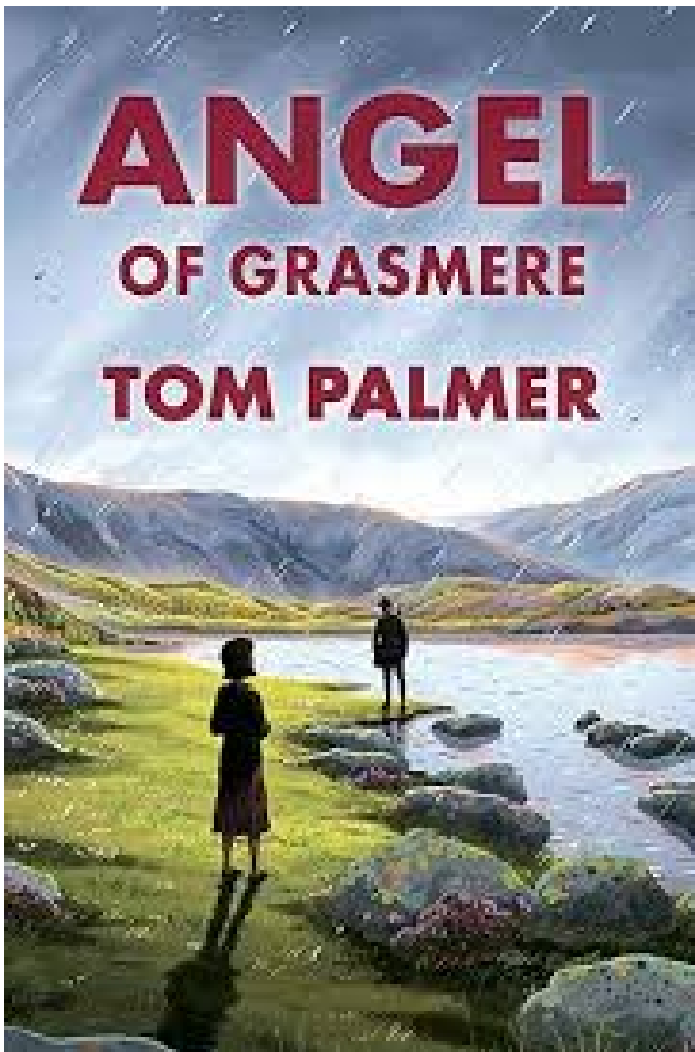
